Australian children are suffering horrendous adverse reactions from ADHD drugs.

- There is an estimated 15,000 prescriptions of antidepressants written for children under 10 in Australia.
- 1181 children under 10 are on antidepressants in NSW, 12 of these are babies under one year old.
- There has been more than a 50% increase in the prescriptions for ADHD drugs in NSW from January 2007 to January 2009.
- In Australia 400 adverse reactions to Ritalin and Dexamphetamine have been reported including a 7 year old on Ritalin trying to run in front of cars and jump off a roof. Other reported side effects include a 5 year old having a stroke and a 7 year old suddenly dying while taking Ritalin.

This is an interactive & visually spectacular touring exhibit. It features documentaries with statements from scores of health professionals, academics, legal and human rights experts.
